## Mission of Amigos De Honduras A Program of the District 7870 Foundation

- Provide Medical and Dental Treatment and Supplies
- Build and Repair Schools
- Provide School Uniforms and Supplies
- Support Pure Water For The World Water Filters and Latrines
- Ship Medical Equipment and Supplies



#### **Amigos De Honduras - Statistics**

- Operations began in 2001 (25 Years)
- •32 mission trips to Danli (26) and San Pedro Sula (6)
- Provide medical and dental treatment and supplies
  - Nearly 30,000 patients seen over the 25 years
  - Over 14.5 tons of medical supplies transported by teams
- Build and repair schools
  - Built 10 new schools and 5 new additions to schools
  - Repaired and painted 19 schools
- Provide school uniforms and supplies
  - Over 400 Uniforms provided for Children
- Support Pure Water for The World and Agua Pura
  - •Installed water filters and water systems serving more than 58,000 people
  - •Installed 29 latrines & these projects provided funds for many more
- Ship medical equipment and supplies
  - Shipped 7 40 foot containers and 3 ambulances



# Due to Covid there were no Mission Teams in 2021 or 2022 But we did fund several projects:

- 2022 El Barro school addition \$8,500
- 2022 El Chaguite PWW project \$4,946
- 2021 Response to hurricanes Eta and Iota
  - 1. Veracruz and Planes Arriba

Serving 300 homes (Approx. 1500 people)

Contributed entire total \$8,000

2. El Portillo serving 85 homes (Approx. 500 people)

Contributed \$2,000 of \$5,200
