Recent Important RI Board Decisions

At their September meeting, the RI Board of Directors made several decisions that relate to District Governors. If you have any questions about these decisions, contact your [CDS team](#).

District Governor Duties and Responsibilities

The Board amends the [Rotary Code of Policies](#) regarding the specific duties and responsibilities of the district governor as follows:

[19.010.6 Governor's Responsibilities for Strategic Planning](#)

Governors will conduct, implement, or review district strategic planning in consultation with the governor-elect and governor-nominee.

District Nominating Committee Reference

The Board agrees that the terms of reference for district nominating committees should specify that there should be no fewer than three members of the nominating committee and members should serve for no more than three one-year terms when a district has adopted a procedure for selecting members on the nominating committee for governor under [RI Bylaws](#) section 14.020.2.

(Note: This new policy would apply to districts that use a nominating committee process, but which have adopted their own rules for selecting members. It does not apply to districts that use the default nominating committee procedure in section 14.020.3 of the RI Bylaws.)
