## OPTIONS

1. A district wide super project
  - The role of the committee automatically becomes one of project leadership.
  - Clubs would contribute financial and human resources. However, there would be no expectation of clubs running their own projects.
2. District selects a narrower focus e.g. promote solar usage within district.
  - Clubs lead projects aligned to the theme.
  - Committee would play an active role in providing expertise, best practice sharing etc.
  - Committee could also lead educational activities across the district.
3. Each club selects its own projects.
  - The role of the committee will be minimal – limited to education and sharing success stories across clubs

Recommend Option 2 as its aligned to the guiding principles
