- **Morley Endowed Grant Scholarship** – established by a generous bequest from a Rotarian and his wife, David and Eleanor Morley, for the sole use of Rotary District 7910, it is managed by The Rotary Foundation Permanent Fund in cooperation with the D7910 Rotary Foundation Scholarship Subcommittee. The window of application of two months will be followed by an interview, and the announcement of one qualified candidate
- **Rotary Global Grant Scholarship** (*formerly the Ambassadorial Scholarship*) – funds graduate-level coursework or research for one to four academic years
- **Rotary Peace Fellowship** – for leaders with work experience in peace and development
