

## Rotary Scholarships

With the reorganization of Rotary scholarships in 2013 the Rotary Ambassadorial Scholarship was discontinued. Future scholarships are now awarded as part of District and Global Grants. Fields of study or research in accordance with Rotary's goals include: ***peace and conflict resolution; disease prevention and treatment; economic and community development; maternal and child health; water and sanitation;*** and, ***basic education and literacy.***

Other scholarship opportunities include:

- **Rotary Peace Fellowships** – For a graduate study program in peace and conflict resolution at one of six designated universities around the world.
- **UNESCO-IHE scholarships** – for a Master of Science degree in urban water and sanitation, water management or water science and engineering at UNESCO-IHE's Delft campus in the Netherlands (administered by The Rotary Foundation)
- **David & Eleanor Morley Endowed Global Grant Scholarship:** For graduate study program abroad for residents of 7910 with preference given to students from Worcester Polytechnic Institute.

Scholarship orientation is done online.

Incoming scholars are traditionally assisted by scholar alumni and senior Rotary leaders thereby establishing an important network link that can assist with future Rotary programs.
