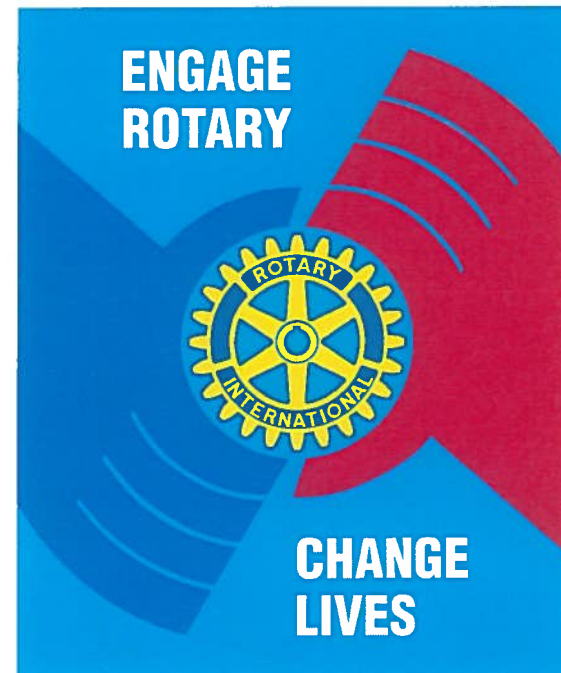

Requirements

- Developing long-range goals that address the elements of an effective club &/or have reviewed them this year
- Setting annual goals that support long-range goals
- Have a plan that keeps all members involved in membership growth/retention and have a net growth in membership by March 30th.
- Communicating effectively with club members and district leaders
- Ensuring continuity in leadership from year to year
- Customizing the bylaws to reflect club operations
- Providing regular fellowship opportunities (min 3 per year)
- Actively involving all club members (At least 80%)
- Offering regular, consistent training.(min 3 events per year)
- Assigning committees that support your club’s operational needs, including: administration, membership, public relations, service projects, and The Rotary Foundation
