During the summer a case of Polio emerged in Rockland County NY. This individual was not vaccinated against the disease.

Rotary knows firsthand that #VaccinesWork. Since 1985, we've contributed more than \$2.1 billion and countless volunteer hours to protect nearly 3 billion children from polio.

When children receive the polio vaccine, their pinkie fingers are marked with purple ink so health workers will know which children received the vaccine. Today, only two countries continue to report cases of polio caused by the wild poliovirus: Afghanistan and Pakistan.

We urge all Interact and EarlyAct Club members to please join the challenge and let's paint all pinkies in your school purple. Funds will be collected and sent to Rotary International to continue the fight.
