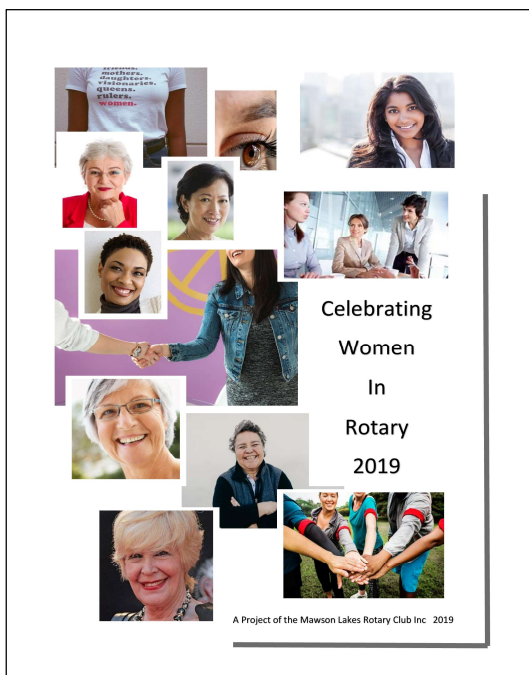


Celebrating Women in Rotary
