

# WE NEED YOUR HELP!

Last year Seaford Rotarian Kally was volunteering teaching Nurses in Mbale Uganda when she was warmly welcomed by the Rotary Club of Mbale, District 9211. Mbale Rotarian Michael shared his dream of opening a health clinic to be supported by the NGO MidPro Initiatives he is the director of. The Rotary Club of Seaford are now partnering with the Rotary Club of Mbale and MidPro Initiatives to make this health clinic a reality.

Midpro has acquired a parcel of land including a building shell of approximately 100m<sup>2</sup>. This land is central to the communities Lukhonje, Bukiende, Bumasikye and Sibanga which have no nearby healthcare facilities. The nearest government or private health care facility is 10 to 15Km away. It is especially dangerous to try to reach these facilities after dark with poor transport options. Local public services are inadequate with four women recently dying in childbirth and it is reported that every month a community loses 4 to 5 people due to various illnesses.

The project is being split into two stages:

- STAGE 1 complete building work including fit out and preparation of clinic facilities
- STAGE 2 source and install medical equipment

To complete stage 1 we need to raise 40,000,000UGX = \$15,750AUD = \$10,700USD
