Update No 2



From the Joint Rotary District Scout Jamboree committee

Hi Club Presidents,

The following is an update as to where we are regarding the area of Australian Jamboree to which we are committed.

1. **The Glenelg and Port Adelaide sites** are now not available to us as the Scout Association elected to have local Scout groups operate them.

In lieu we have been offered (and we have accepted) to provide **Breakfast on Friday 4 January** for the 3,100 NSW contingent of scouts and leaders for the morning of their arrival .

We are currently working through the logistics of this. We will need a strong contingent of workers.

2. The Jamboree Mall

This will operate for the ten (10) days and Rotary will be providing a casual catering service.

- Ice Cream and Soft drinks
- BBQ – serving steak and egg sandwiches, Kababs and possibly pancakes,
- Donuts.
- We will have two marquees – one will be the BBQ marquee and one “Information” marquee which will promote our Youth programs and also other Rotary programmes. Rotaractors will set up and be present. Liz Gardner, District Rotaract Representative will be coordinating.

3. Equipment

The committee is supplying and setting up all facilities – Marquees, BBQs, serving tables, chairs, rest area, cool room for the BBQ food, etc. **All we need from you and your club is labour.**

For those working into the evening, a marquee will be available in the adjacent Scout caravan park for you to sleep in .

4. Shifts

The proposed shifts are:-

First shift	9.00am till 1.00pm	8 to 10 volunteers required
Second shift	1.00pm till 5.00pm	8 to 10 volunteers required
Third shift	5.00pm till 8.00/8.30pm	the clean up – 10 to 12 volunteers required

Each shift can be filled by two clubs, one from each district.

It is up to each club to manage its labour for the day

- There will be 13,000 scouts, leaders and various works/support crews during the 10 days.
- On most days 6,000 to 7,000 scouts and leaders will leave the site for various external activities – Glenelg, Port Adelaide, City, Woodside etc.
- Of the 3,000 to 5,000 remaining most will be involved in various activities on site and most in the Mall area and choose refreshments.
- We are looking for two clubs a day – one club from 9500 and the other from 9520.
- **5 Parking and Parking attendants**

I thank those who have come on board and we have some spots yet to be filled, please contact me if you are interested.

2. a calendar showing clubs allocated each day Please advise if this does not suit.

The vacant shifts are to be filled by clubs yet to commit.

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
