These students, together with their families and club counsellors are invited to attend this one-day briefing to cover important aspects for the exchange, including- Medical & Accident Insurance, Use of social media, Child protection, packing, Rotary rules, their Visa demands, language and schooling, home-sickness and the role of the Counsellor, amongst other things.

During this day they are also given their green Exchange Blazer to identify them as exchange students, together with a backpack, a thumb-drive with important paperwork on it and their flight date and details for starting their exchange in January.

The day will start at 10.30am and is being organised as a series of workshops to be held at the Clare Rotary Club facility at Melrose Reserve in Clare. Members of the committee will present various sessions, with contributions being given by current inbounds students from overseas, from recently returned exchange students and their parents, as well as people who have acted as host parents in the past.
