



Great Fundraiser – bigger than Bunnings BBQ's

Further to the previous information

Districts 9500 and 9520 have been approached by Scouts Australia to provide support to the National Scouts Jamboree being held at Tailem Bend from Friday 4 January to Monday 14 January 2019. This service is also an opportunity to raise funds for your Club. Rotary has been offered three options, outlined below, for our consideration and we are now asking Clubs to express their interest in being involved in this major project. Jeff Cluse, 9500 District Team Leader for Club Administration, is coordinating this project on behalf of both Districts and is currently **looking for committee members** as well as **expressions of interest** from Clubs across both Districts via the registration form at the back of this document.

We are seeking interested clubs in this potential great fundraising opportunity to register their interest in providing labour and possible equipment, either for a day or more than one day. Clubs could join with another club to provide suitable labour in two to three shifts.

There are **three** fundraising opportunities in different locations:

At the Tailem Bend site:-

We will have 3 marquees

Marquee 1: will handle the BBQ – Steak Sandwiches, Kebabs, Egg and Bacon Sandwiches.

Marquee 2: Chips and Donuts.

Marquee 3: Drinks and ice-creams

The above 3 Marquees will be located in the "Mall" which will be set up to provide after meals activities including snacks (3 stalls by Rotary), Bakery, Groceries, jumping Castle etc.

Some Scouts and Leaders will be away on day activities to places like Wellington (water activities), Glenelg (Beach activities), Port Adelaide (various activities) and the city (sight-seeing), other will remain in camp being involved in on site activities.

The busiest time is expected after 6pm when the scouts and leaders have had their dinner and are looking for further entertainment, they will then visit the "Mall" – our captive audience.

The committee is planning to pre-set the marquees up including the other items including tables, chairs BBQ, chip cooker, donut machine, cool room, etc. prior to the 4 January 2019, so all we are after is labour for the day. We envisage two shifts (clubs can modify, subject to approval) – 9:00am to 3:00pm and 3:00pm to 8:30pm.

We are looking for a variety of equipment including marquees, tables (to work and serve from), tables and chairs for patrons, and the variety of cooking equipment: BBQ's, donut machine, chip cooker, cool room etc. – the list is still being developed.

We are planning to pre-purchase the food – we are looking to clubs to turn up and cook and provide.

The drinks and ice-cream are being provided by Scouts Australia – we just need to serve and collect the payment.

We are also looking to provide a Rotary promotion marquee and possibly focus mainly on our youth programs, RYLA, RYPEN etc. with more adult promotion for visitors, etc. The committee will provide three floats for the day (one for each marquee) and will collect the takings at the end of the day.

A fourth marquee will be provided for Rotarians to relax in during their shift and will be located at the back the three marquees.

At the Glenelg and Port Adelaide sites:-

We are after two clubs to be involved each day – one at each site to provide the premade food.

This is the main dinner for the scouts and leaders. They will finish their activities in the above areas and are ready to be bussed back to camp.

The club responsible for the meal will pick up from a designated supplier (possibly Subway) and transport it to the nominated site where the scouts and leaders will board their buses.

You will need to provide tables to serve from.

Scouts Australia will pay Rotary for this service – no collecting of payment required.

All persons assisting on the days must have standard Police Clearance.

Previous information

Rotary Clubs in 9500/9520 are requested to register their interest to provide BBQ at the up and coming Scout Jamboree January 2019

URGENT REGISTRATION REQUIRED.

The Jamboree is from Friday 4 January to Monday 14 January 2019.

A joint district committee has been formed and approved by both incoming District Governors and led by myself Jeff Cluse – current District Secretary 9500. Rotary has been offered 3 options. The Jamboree is being held at The Bend International Race Track just out of Tailem Bend on the road to Melbourne with estimated 10,000 scouts, 5,000 Leaders plus assistants and hired labour and on the Saturday 30,000 parents and friends is anticipated to attend.

Option 1 – Tailem Bend:

Marquee 1: Chips and Donuts

Marquee 2: Ice-cream and Drinks

Marquee 3: BBQ – Steak Sandwiches, Egg/Bacon Sandwiches, Kebabs etc.

We have been advised that the kids will be “sausaged” out, however there is a continual flow of visitors and workers during the day (up to 500) with serious top ups by the Scouts and their leaders (around 6,000) after their evening meal.

The committee is considering nominating Clubs that show expressions of interest to set up the marquees, BBQ and all other machinery and purchase the food etc. and man their stalls. The suggested times are 9am till 8pm with 6 to 8 being really busy. The Jamboree supplies all power, water and toilets.

The marquees will be set up in a proposed “Mall” with other stalls including Post Office, Scout Shop, Medical Centre, Bakery, Souvenirs etc. There may be some other food type stalls.

Option 2 – Glenelg:

Provide pre-made night time dinner (possibly Subway etc.) meal for the scouts and leaders to eat on the bus on the way back to camp at Tailem Bend. Around 600 each day for about 7 days.

This will be served at approx. 6:00pm – will need to be picked up from Subway or similar and set up at the Glenelg site and handed out to the Scouts and leaders.

Option 3 – Port Adelaide:

Provide pre-made night time dinner (possibly Subway etc.) meal for the Scouts and leaders to eat on the bus on the way back to camp at Tailem Bend. Around 600 a day for 7 days.

This will be served at approx. 6:00pm – will need to be picked up from Subway or wherever and set up at the Port Adelaide site and handed out to the Scouts and leaders.
