John Fisher, Chairman Rotary D9500 of the Disaster Recovery Committee has forwarded the following to our D9500

Dear Rotarians

I am sharing this with you as we have worked together in the past and I am hoping you can either attend and/or help us publicise this event.

The idea for the Fire Season Ready Family Expo came from the women who attended the Firey Women workshop in Freeling in July. This group of 17 women came from several areas across the fire ground and beyond. They were all fire affected, some devastatingly so, and very keen to be better prepared. The group decided to keep in touch and suggested a reunion in the Spring to check their plans and to help allay their anxiety about the next fire season.

Over 70 women attended Firey Women workshops in CFS Region 2 (which includes the Pinery Fire area) during the past winter season. They are all invited to attend together with previous years' 'graduates'.

The idea was then discussed with our Recovery colleagues (including the local NRM representative) and together the idea has grown into an Expo event. Besides our Firey Women Reunion there will be a number of other presenters and entertainers.

I am sure it will be an informative and inspiring day.

Jarrold Cresp of the Port Adelaide Recreation Centre (Basketball SA) and NWBL referee wrote "I just thought I would send some information concerning the Guinness World Record attempt. On October 22 & 23 our wheelchair basketball players will be trying to break the record for the longest continuous wheelchair basketball game. They will be aiming to play for 32 hours!

This will occur on the **22 & 23 October at Titanium Sports** Arena (formerly Adelaide Arena) (44a Crittenden Road, Findon), from Saturday 9:00am till Sunday 5:00pm. In charge of the project is Jacob Gracey Development Officer, Disability Recreation and Sports SA and Adam from the Adelaide Thunder Wheelchair Basketball team. Massage Life & the Australian Institute of Fitness have come on board to help.

The purpose of the event is to raise much needed funds and awareness for wheelchair basketball in South Australia so it would be great to see as many people there as possible. Adelaide was a foundation member team of the NWBL in 1988 and between then and 2013 won the flag five times. They are looking to come back in.

Everyone is welcome to come along! I understand that Adelaide 36ers and MAC Lightning have also joined on board for support.
