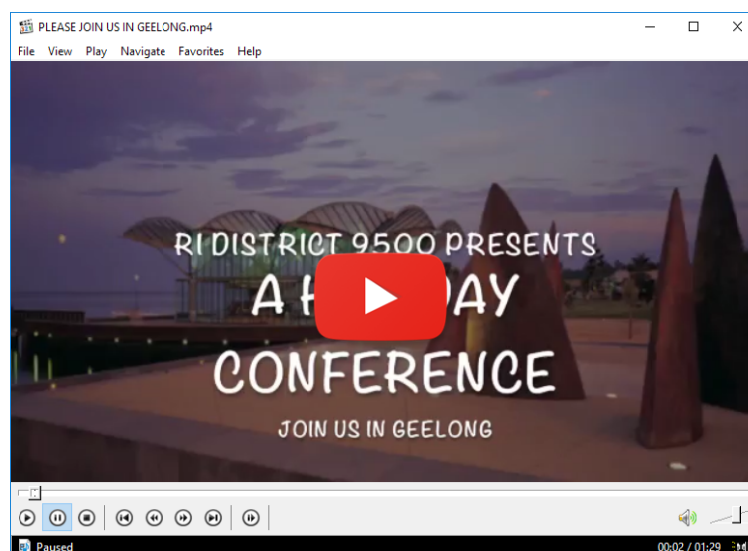

The Mall will be a shaded precinct within the site. Dimensions 300m x 100m.

As part of the Jamboree there will be 'Super Saturday' or visitor's day, where up 30,000 parents and friends are anticipated to attend.
