Jarrod Cresp of the Port Adelaide Recreation Centre (Basketball SA) and NWBL referee wrote "I just thought I would send some information concerning the Guinness World Record attempt. On October 22 & 23 our wheelchair basketball players will be trying to break the record for the longest continuous wheelchair basketball game. They will be aiming to play for 32 hours! This will occur on the 22 & 23 October at Titanium Sports Arena (formerly Adelaide Arena) (44a Crittenden Road, Findon), from Saturday 9:00am till Sunday 5:00pm. In charge of the project is Jacob Gracey Development Officer, Disability Recreation and Sports SA and Adam from the Adelaide Thunder Wheelchair Basketball team. Massage Life & the Australian Institute of Fitness have come on board to help. The purpose of the event is to raise much needed funds and awareness for wheelchair basketball in South Australia so it would be great to see as many people there as possible. Adelaide was a foundation member team of the NWBL in 1988 and between then and 2013 won the flag five times. They are looking to come back in. Everyone is welcome to come along! I understand that Adelaide 36ers and MAC Lightning have also joined on board for support.
