The intrepid explorers aptly named *The Ulaan Bastaards*; Adam, Brady, Sam and Hamish, have thought it would be a great idea to give up two months of their life to participate in the 2018 Mongol Rally. Just a little trip, 2 months on the road, traversing the best and worst roads Europe and Central Asia have to offer.
