### **Grant Report:**

The Rotary Club of Quezon City Circle and the Principal of that school took charge of the project. I asked them to break the project into 5 stages and this was done. Funds were released to the Rotary Club of Quezon City circle for stages 1, 2, 3 and on completion funds were released for the final 2 stages.

Receipts for work done “Labour and Materials”, was copied and sent to us here in Australia, the original receipts were brought back from Manila by myself in March and are with our Club.

On the second of March 2015 my wife and I were invited to attend the official opening of the renovated comfort room.

The workmanship and quality of materials was beyond my expectations. The project was finished on time and within budget. Sonia Sajonia from the Quezon City Circle Rotary Club took charge and spending of the funds.

Already one can see the benefits of this restoration, from a rundown unsanitary facility used for storing junk to a facility that the students and teachers are proud to own.

It is my understanding that the school has appointed a person to take care of this facility. The opening of the facility was conducted by myself and President Bing Quite of the Quezon City Circle Rotary Club.
