Multiple Earthquakes in Mindanao

In late October the Philippine Island of Mindanao was hit by three major earthquakes.

In response we have been supporting our local Partner Balay Mindanaw in delivering aid to those affected.

In addition to financial support and materials from Disaster Aid Australia many Philippine organisations have also been working with Balay Mindanaw.

Our board member Dr Angeline Low with her husband Danny were already in the area and after seeing the problems donated a SkyHydrant.

Other SkyHydrants were used in conjunction with water tankers from the local fire departments to deliver safe drinking water to many different communities.



Bhutan 2020 Progress

In November DAA will be shipping a further 10 units to Bhutan.

This will mean our ambitious project to provide safe drinking water to every major school in Bhutan will be 50% complete.
