*IFFR Australia is offering someone the chance to **receive** \$5000 to go towards their flying training.*

There are many avenues into obtaining your pilots license – either through an RA Aus affiliated flying school or a CASA General Aviation training school. Costs vary depending on the training school, type of aircraft used and how long it takes you to learn the skills. Talk to your preferred school and they will give you the pros and cons of the different pathways and the budget required. It's likely to start at about \$7500 for an RA Aus Pilots certificate and a few grand more if you choose the CASA Recreational Pilots License.

Talk it over with Mum, Dad or Guardian, make sure their happy to support your flying training and get them to fill out this bit.
