The Shine On Recognitions is a Multi-District Program conducted by the Rotary Southern Districts. This program recognises outstanding service by people with varying abilities, who, by their actions, serve as a “Shining Examples” to the community

Guidelines for Nomination

Eligible Nominees are people who are actively involved in community service for the benefit of others, and have demonstrated a significant level of achievement, whilst managing a specific medical disorder/disability, and have consistently given dedicated service to the community

Nominees must give examples of personal achievement in:

- Leadership and/or mentoring of others with a disability
- Membership and/or leadership in community groups
- Service to the community and/or a history of community achievement
- Other special awards or forms of recognition

Nominations for the Rotary Southern Districts Shine On Recognitions must be endorsed by a Rotary Club. Any club or association may nominate more than one person.

Nomination Categories;

Group 1: Age 15-25 years as at December in each year of nomination.

Group 2: Age 25 years and over

The Shine on Recognitions are held annually at a Presentation Ceremony.

The Rotary Southern Districts ‘Shine On’ Recognition Event will be held on Sunday 22nd April 2018, at Meadows Greyhound Racing Function Centre, Northgate Drive, Broadmeadows
1 pm – 4 pm.

This year the event will be hosted by the Rotary Club of Moreland District 9790.

Closing date for nomination is 15th December 2017.

A nomination form will be available in October 2017 and will be put in Vocational Service link onto the District 9780 website.
