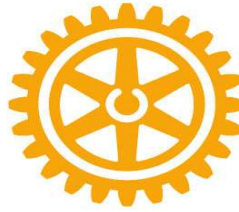

## **Accomplishments**

The District Rotary Foundation Committee provided \$44,768 in Local District Grants to 28 clubs this Rotary year to do good in local communities

\$15,000 in Global Grants for our Guatemala Hearing Aid project, led by Dr. Sheryl Figliano of the Boardman Club. This funding, matched with Rotary Foundation funds and generous donors, will provide more than \$51,000 for hearing aids and support for children in Guatemala to do good in the world

\$5,000 for a Bone Bank in India, led by Dr. Meena Patel of the Salem Club. This funding, matched with Rotary Foundation funds and generous donors, will provide more than \$51,000 for bone transplants providing repairs for trauma patients, spinal surgeries, and cancers to do good in the world

\$13,897 in Global Grants for PolioPlus. This funding, matched by the Bill Gates Foundation, will provide \$63,000 to End Polio Now to finish the fight against this disease

3<sup>rd</sup> Annual Purple Pinkie Fundraiser raised \$7,748 also with matching funding from the Bill Gates Foundation for \$21,000+ additional funds to fight this disease

The Paul Harris Fellow Challenge had 180 donors and raised \$46,000 this year enlarging what we can do locally and globally

Rotary District 6650 is about to become a 100% Peacebuilder District, giving to the 3 peace funds to help peace prevail in the world

Monthly District Leadership Team Meetings continued to grow and strengthen our leadership
