William Elliott Award for International Service

This award is named for William H. Elliott, president of the Miverva club in 1966-67 and one of the youngest governors to have served our district. The international service award recognizes a club project that positively impacts people around the world.

Winner: E. Liverpool, Salem, Calcutta

Runner up: Boardman

The Rotary clubs of East Liverpool, Salem and Calcutta are recognized for their impressive international service efforts. Together, these clubs spearheaded an effort to produce clean water and improved sanitation for a primary school in Tanzania. Within three short months, these clubs committed \$5,300 in funds, which will grow to over \$20,000 with the support of Proctor and Gamble and the Rotary International Foundation. Because of their service, over 500 students and fourteen teachers now have access to twenty pit latrines and two hand-wash facilities – up from three latrines.
