It is time to start to think about our Cards for Veterans program. Last year you collected 9,748 cards that were distributed to Veterans in VA Medical facilities in Southwestern Pennsylvania. We started this Districtwide Interact Project in 2014 and since then we have sent a total of 25,624 holiday cards to our veterans. Remember that cards **must not** be in envelopes (some veterans are unable to open them and the VA needs to know what is coming into their facilities), cards should not be religious in nature (as not all veterans are Christians), cards can contain a short message to thank the veteran for his/her service and can be signed with a first name only.

In the past Interact Clubs have gotten their schools involved, especially the elementary schools in their district and some Interact Clubs have also involved their sponsoring Rotary Club. Cards can be store bought or homemade! Cards however should not contain any glitter.

Once the cards have been collected and in one place, members of the VFW will take them to the various medical facilities when they make their Christmas visits. Each day for the week between Christmas and New Years the veterans receive a card with each meal they are served.

Additional details and dates will be announced in the October issue of the District 7305 Interact Newsletter but remember that ALL Interact Clubs in the District are invited to participate in this project.






Two big international events are on the horizon that your Interact Club might want to observe and/or celebrate.
