Description of objectives:

To create a manual about Prevention of Violence, Delinquency and Victim Assistance.

Train 100 people to help in these areas in three different parts of the State of Morelos.

Identify and make a call to replicators of the Model Vigilant Neighbor Rotarian Zone Zero, for training and of course, public ministries, psychologist experts and 3-pint ministerial police in the state who want to join a new generation of social commitment.

Define topics to aboard.



The problem:



- No clear limits to achieve coexistence among people or open dialogue.
- Prevention matters in our state of Morelos is very weak.
- Efforts have gone to prevent crime and to give attention to victims, so the situation has exceeded the government resources, generating a defective, indifferent government response, lacking experience and manners.
- The lack of effective work from government employees stops intended services from being implemented properly and delays society's progress.
- Repression against citizens that dare to file a formal criminal complaint.
- Either through intention or incompetence items are omitted or “misplaced” in the investigation folder.
- General lack of knowledge of the new judicial penal system from the government clerks, district attorneys, public and private advocates and general citizens.
- There are no documents or manuals or serious training that bring up the actual difficulties and the way to address them, to repair them and stay abreast with the constant changes in the Mexican justice system.
- Prevention is required for the care and attention of children and students, to educate to the risks of natural disasters, and the consequences of committing crimes.
- Nowadays, violence and delinquency are not only physical crimes, but now there are also online cyber crimes. Online crimes damage people financially, their integrity and dignity.

Goals that the activity support:

- Disseminate responsibility for vulnerable groups care (child, women, elderly and handicapped people, and minority groups)
- Prevent cyber risk
- Report obligations when called upon to declare by an authority
- Socializing the criminal justice system
- Inhibit corruption within justice system



Direct and indirect beneficiaries:

- 100 people directly from replicators of the Model Vigilant Neighbor Rotarian Zone Zero, public ministers, psychologist experts and ministerial police in the state.
- Indirectly, those people who file a formal complaint.
