### Sunday morning, October 27th, 10:00am - Noon

Service Project (building repair) at Fundación Nuevos Horizontes (A school for children with special needs) We will go from the ship to Nuevos Horizontes by bus – short drive (10 min) – no cost to AZ Rotarians

### As part of this project, D5500 is sending the Rotarians in D4100 \$2,600 to pay for the building repairs

- 1. Before we arrive, professional repairs will be completed: roof repairs, plumbing installed, electrical expanded.
- 2. The day of our project, Rotarians will divide up into 6 groups to complete the work:
  - a. Installation of fixtures (e.g., door knobs) 4+ people needed
  - b. Paint front door & install fixtures 2+ people needed
  - c. Paint outside of building 10+ people needed
  - d. Work on gravel with shovels and wheelbarrows (somewhat strenuous) 10+ people needed
  - e. Clean windows & floors 6+ people needed
  - f. Clean patio 12+ people needed
    - \*\* Bring work gloves and work clothes; all other tools and supplies will be provided by D4100
    - \*\*\* Weather may be cool in October (60s) near the port; somewhat warmer inland for lunch.
