## Club Eligibility Requirements for 2024-2025 Grants

- 1) Clubs must complete the Club Qualification on the District 5440 website <https://rotary5440.org/page/district-grant-qualifications>
- 2) Clubs must have an annual Foundation giving goal entered in Rotary Club Central.
- 3) Clubs must have per capita Foundation giving of at least \$50.
- 4) Clubs Must not have any overdue grant reports
- 5) Clubs must not have any open grants older than two years from issuance of DDF funds.

## Important Deadlines for 2024-2025 “District” Grants

***NOTE: “Global” Grants can be submitted at any time***

**June 7, 2024 – All ‘24 - 25 district grants need to be submitted in [matchinggrants.org](http://matchinggrants.org)**

- District grants can be either a local community or an international grant.
- It must be humanitarian in nature and have Rotary member involvement.
- All grants are matched 2-1 up to the amount that that a club is eligible for per the district grant policy.

**December 6, 2024 – 2nd District grants must be submitted in [matchinggrants.org](http://matchinggrants.org)**

- The max DDF that will be matched to club funds will be set based on the amount of money left after the first round of grants
- Clubs that have not received any grants that year will get priority. Once those grants have been approved the remaining monies will be split among the rest of the grant requests.
