Meet our District Governor-Elect

I had the pleasure of meeting **Chris Woodruff** several years ago when I served as the Assistant Governor for the Greeley clubs in 2011-2013.

Chris is the retired Assessor in Weld County Colorado. He makes his home In Greeley. He completed a forty year career in property appraisal and assessment, with work experience in three Colorado counties and the Colorado Division of Property Taxation. Chris has a B.S. degree in Technical Management from Regis University and is a Certified General Real Estate Appraiser.

Chris became a Rotarian in 2000 when he joined the Rotary Club of Greeley - Centennial. In the club he has served as Secretary, President and Foundation Chair. He was named club Rotarian of the Year three times.

At the district level, Chris served as Assistant Governor for the Estes Park, Colorado clubs, Awards Committee chairman, TRF mentor and

as a member of the District Foundation Com-

mittee. He has also presented at several District Assemblies and has served as a facilitator at High Country PETS. In early 2017, he was selected to serve as District Governor for the 2019-2020 Rotary year.

Chris travelled to Saratov, Russia as part of a District 5440 delegation attending the chartering of a new club in that city. On that trip he saw the power of Rotary in transforming people's lives by providing a means to connect across great geographic, cultural and language differences.

He is married to **Karoline**, who is also a Rotarian. Karoline is a past Club President and current Assistant Governor. Karoline retired from a career in higher education in 2016.

AG Shurie Scheel named District Governor Nominee Designate (DGND)



Shurie Scheel from the Rotary Club of Thermopolis was chosen to serve as the Governor of District 5440 for the Rotary year 2021-22 by the District 5440 Nominating Committee. Shurie has served as assistant governor for the Lander, Thermopolis and Riverton clubs since 2016 and is currently co-chair of the District Rotary Leadership Institute Committee.

Shurie and her husband Phillip have two children, Kaden, 10 and Alayna, 8. They own and manage Tumbleweed Propane Company, serving residential and industrial customers in a 100-mile radius around Thermopolis.

Shurie celebrates her ninth year with the Thermopolis club in March. She is a Paul Harris Fellow and a member of the Bequest Society. She attended Emerging Leaders

training at the 2016 Rotary Zone Institute in Salt Lake City and is a Rotary Leadership Institute graduate and facilitator.

Shurie and Phillip have also helped to manage a Global Grant clean water project for rural schools in Kenya and plan to return there for their fifth visit this year. The Thermopolis club now leads the project, after it was initially developed and managed by the Scottsbluff-Gering club. The grant has brought clean water to about 27,000 kids from 80 rural schools in Kenya through water filtration, education, and rain water harvesting technology.

Shurie is the Vice President of Human Care and board member of the Wyoming Lutheran Women's missionary league, secretary of the local parent-teacher organization, treasurer of the Big Horn Basin Nature and Discovery Center and vice president of the center's natural resources planning committee. She also serves on various committees in the Thermopolis-Hot Springs Chamber of Commerce and Main Street Thermopolis and teaches the early childhood Sunday school class at her church.

She will attend High Country PETS in March and begin the three-year training program with her classmates from Rotary zones 26 and 27 in September.


