Membership Attraction and Engagement

Must accomplish first item and at least one of next two items

- Achieve a net gain in membership. Clubs up to 50 members must achieve a net gain of 1 member. Clubs larger than 50 members must achieve a net gain of at least 2 members.
- Use a Survey, Club Assembly or other means to learn what your members value about Rotary and what specific things can be done to meet the needs and interests of your membership.

OR

• Conduct a Club Visioning or **Revisioning Session**

Rotary Foundation

(minimum three)

- Attain a minimum Annual Fund Contribution of \$100 per capita
- Increase the number of Paul Harris Society members by at least one
- Increase the number of benefactors/ bequest society members by at least one
- Send at least one member to the District Centennial Foundation Dinner in April, 2017

Humanitarian Service

(minimum two)

- Sponsor at least one project funded by a global grant or district grant.
 - Participate in a Community Polio **Awareness Event**
 - Complete one local service project and submit photos and an article for district newsletter.

Leadership Development

(minimum three)

- Graduate members from the Rotary Leadership Institute Clubs up to 50 members must graduate one member. Clubs larger than 50 members must graduate 2 members
 - Send 2 members to the Spring District Assembly.
 - Send 2 members to the Fall District Assembly
 - · Send 2 members to the District Conference


