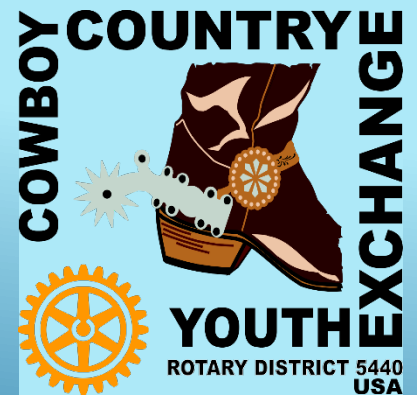
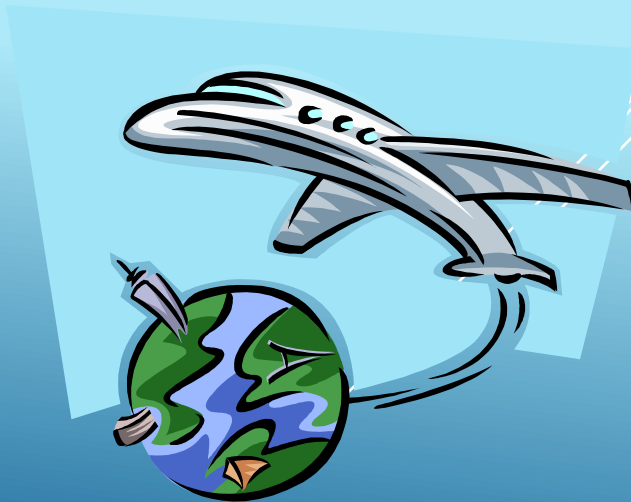

- ▶ 1.4 million members from 200 countries

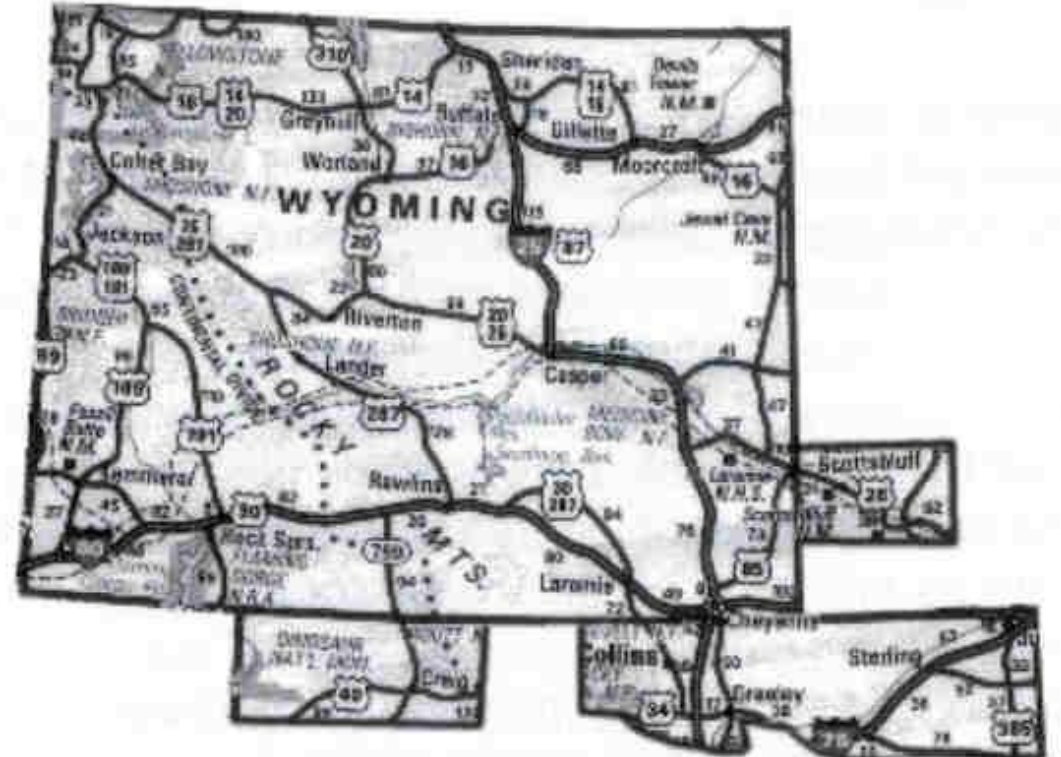
Rotary

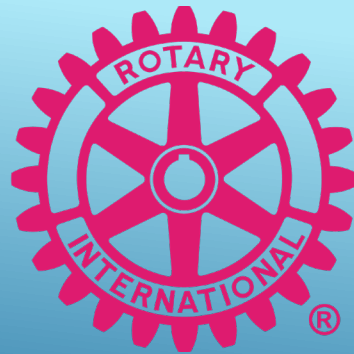

WILL IT BUILD GOODWILL AND BETTER FRIENDSHIPS?

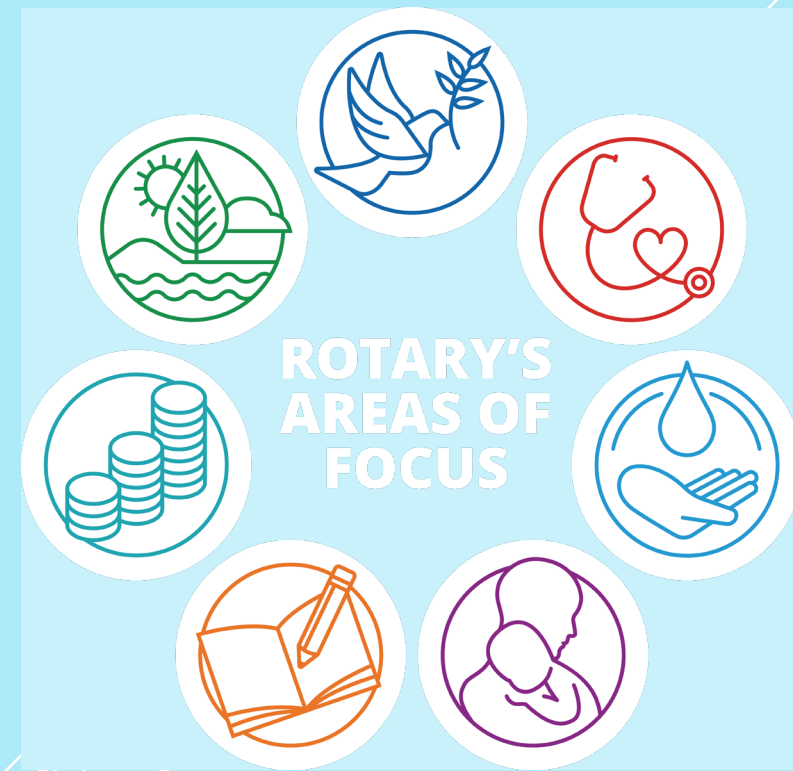
- ▶ Fellowship

Rotary is dedicated to seven areas of focus to build international relationships, improve lives, and create a better world to support our peace efforts and end polio forever.

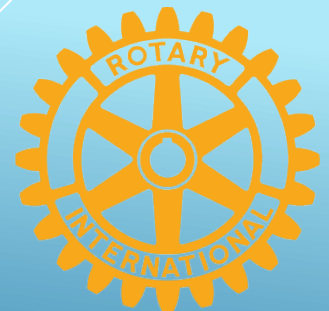
PROMOTING PEACE

- ▶ We educate and equip communities to stop the spread of life-threatening diseases like polio, HIV/AIDS, and malaria. We improve and expand access to low-cost and free health care in developing areas

- ▶ We support local solutions to bring clean water, sanitation, and hygiene to more people every day. We don't just build wells and walk away.

- ▶ Nearly 6 million children under the age of five die each year because of malnutrition, poor health care, and inadequate sanitation. We expand access to quality care, so mothers and their children can live and grow stronger
