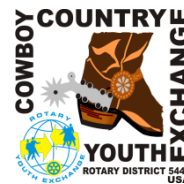

Student and Parent Acknowledgement of Fees and Payment Schedule

District 5440 charges a flat fee to cover most of the costs associated with the exchange. For the 2021-22 exchange year this fee is \$6,000. One hundred dollars is refunded to students who attend the rebound orientation in August of 2022.

Included in flat fee:

- Round trip airfare with a 12-month changeable ticket and one change (Meets strict Rotary safety guidelines. Departure airport and date selected to reduce cost)
- Airport transfers on arrival and departure (students are met at the airport by a program representative)
- Rotary-approved health and personal liability insurance
- Assistance with obtaining visa and travel arrangements
- Cost of consulate visit to obtain visa (if required)
- Cost of visa fees.
- Language camp upon arrival in host country (if required by Rotary host)
- Online subscription to Rosetta Stone or Pimsleur language learning program (depends on language)
- Pre-departure and in-country orientations
- Rotary blazer
- D5440 T-shirt and hoodie
- Business cards
- Name badge
- U.S. Flag and state flag
- District 5440 pins (50)
- Food and/or snacks for student and parents at mandatory interview and orientation
- Program administration costs

Provided by Host District and Families

- Room and board (home stay)
- School tuition
- Monthly stipend

Not included in flat fee:

- Personal expenses (e.g., toiletries, phone, clothing, internet, club fees, activities)
 - School expenses (e.g., uniform, lunches, supplies, bus pass, transport to and from school, school activities, etc.)
 - Emergency Fund (\$300 to \$400 paid to club on arrival for emergency use, refunded if not used)
 - Passport fees
 - Physical and dental exams
 - Language tutoring (if necessary)
 - Luggage, camera, cell phone, computer
 - Year-end tours & recreational travel
 - Pocket money
 - Lodging at interview or orientation
 - Insurance deductibles
 - Date change charges for return ticket beyond one change
 - Incidental expenses
 - Excess luggage fees
 - Additional airfare flying out of smaller airports or on peak days (flat fee includes Denver, Salt Lake City, Casper and Billings. We will seek alternative airports and departure dates if prices are too high)
 - Any other item not specified

Payments

A \$750 application fee is due with the application on or before October 31, 2020.

Three payments of \$1,750 are due January 1, March 1 and April 1. Other payment options can be arranged with our Treasurer. Regardless of the payment plan, the full \$6,000 must be paid no later than April 1, 2021 (prior to the orientation).

Refunds

If students are not selected at the December 5, 2020 interviews they will receive a \$650 refund of their application fee.

Students who are selected to participate and withdraw from the program will receive a partial refund of the application fee depending on when they withdraw.

Withdraw prior to December 31, 2020 Refund = \$300

Withdraw on or after January 1, 2021 No refund of application fee

If a student withdraws prior to May 1 they will receive any additional fees paid beyond the application fee, less any purchases made on their behalf. Refunds after May 1 will be very limited because most of the purchases will have been made, those will be negotiated on a case-by-case basis.

Covid-19 impacts are difficult to predict. We will be flexible and fair about reimbursements if exchanges are cancelled and charge only for the costs incurred.

Mandatory Events

Both parents and student MUST attend interview and orientation events. Attending the orientation may require missing prom, state athletic events or other school activities. Students and parents should check their schedules and confirm that they can attend these required events prior to submitting an application.

District interviews will be held in Cheyenne, WY on December 5, 2020.

Outbound student orientation will be held in Casper, WY on April 2-4, 2021.

Rebound Orientation

The district holds an event for the exchange students after the completion of their exchange year. It is not mandatory, but those who attend will receive a \$100 refund of their application fee. The event for 2021-2022 students will be in Casper, WY on August 6, 2022.

Acknowledgement of Fee Structure and Agreement to Pay
