

Rotary 5440 District Scholarship

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 1) The applicant agrees to learn about Rotary International, The Rotary Foundation and Rotary Districts and Rotary Clubs and visit a Rotary club near where they are studying if there is one nearby.
- 2) To study in one of Rotary's six areas of focus: Peace and Conflict Resolution, Water and Sanitation, Disease Prevention and Treatment, Economic and Community Development, Education and Literacy, Maternal and Child Health.
- 3) The applicant must be well above average in academic standing at their institution.
- 4) To permit District 5440 to use the applicant's name and all photographs and written reports generated through activities related to the scholarship.
- 5) The Scholar may NOT be (1) a Rotarian; (2) an employee of a club, district, or any other Rotary entity, or of Rotary International; (3) the spouse, a descendant, or an ancestor (parent or grandparent by blood) of any person in the foregoing two categories. The scholar may be a member of a Rotaract club.
- 6) To adhere to all of the requirements, rules and regulations of the University's scholarship program and these Terms and Conditions.
- 7) The applicant certifies that they have the resources available to cover other expenses not met by this scholarship.
- 8) That once the scholarship has been approved by the District 5440 Regional Scholarship Committee, the type of scholarship awarded cannot be changed.
- 9) That the scholarship may only be used to fund or help fund: Tuition and Fees, Housing, Airfare, Meals, Books and Educational Supplies. All other costs are the responsibility of the student.
- 10) To keep all receipts for expenditures covered by the scholarship and submit a final report at the end of the studies.

11) To agree to visit the Rotary clubs that are in the region that sponsored the scholarship after the studies are complete.

12) To become a member of the District 5440 scholarship alumni

13) That the scholarship may be revoked for any of the following reasons: inability to secure admission to the program; low level of academic achievement; evidence of misconduct; failure to submit required reports on time; change in study program without the consent of the university or community scholarship program and Rotary District 5440; withdrawal from the program prior to expiration of the scholarship term; failure to perform duties. I understand that revocation of a scholarship shall cause all payments to cease and may make me liable for the return of payments previously provided.

14) That Rotary International, The Rotary Foundation, Rotary District 5440 and its clubs and individual Rotarians, The Scholarship Program, and the study institution or program are in no way liable for a scholar's personal welfare or responsible for enabling a scholar to pursue his or her studies beyond the scholarship period. The above entities assume no responsibility or obligations whatsoever beyond providing the amount of the scholarship.
