



Ridin' With a Rotarian!

Denton County has announced a partnership with DCTA (Denton County Transportation Authority) and with Span, Inc of Denton county. The aim is to provide additional transportation options to the Denton County Public Health Vaccination Clinics. Any individuals with a confirmed appoint will be able to ride a bus nearest to their appointment time at 8 a.m., 10 a.m., noon or 2 p.m. at two locations – the [DCTA Downtown Denton Transit Center](#), 604 E. Hickory St., in Denton or the [Hebron Station](#), 952 Lakeside Circle in Lewisville.

How can we help as Rotarians?

There may be times when an individual is unable to access these options and may need a ride to either of these DCTA stations or perhaps to the clinic location itself. This is where a Rotarian comes in to help someone get where they need to be to get the vaccine.

We are asking each club within Denton County to identify a minimum of 5 individuals who are willing to provide rides on an “as-need” basis. The hope is that “if” a ride is requested, we will be able to identify a Rotarian who lives nearby who has the availability to provide a ride. To this end, we want to build a database of Rotarians who may have some availability so you may have the option to perform this ride service to assist a fellow Denton County citizen.
