




* Grant Funding

- 1. Identify Candidates NOW!
- 2. Candidates complete online application.
- 3. Club interviews and selects one candidate.
- 4. Send application to Chair by Oct 31, 2025.
- 5. District Interviews held Sat Nov 8, 2025.
- 6. For Selected Candidates
 - a) Club completes application at www.matchinggrants.org
 - b) Club completes global grant application at www.rotary.org
- 7. Candidate attends GSETS* in Houston Jan 3, 2026






APPLICATION ROAD MAP (ref files on left)

- 1. Read current:
 - Global Grant Scholarship Outline
- Complete GG Scholar Application Sections 1-3 and obtain sponsoring Rotary Club endorsement.
- 3. Submit Scholarship Application to the D5790 GG Scholarship Chair.
- 4. Attend D5790 GG Scholarship Committee interview.
- Selected candidates should complete GG Scholarship Application Section 4 and send copies to the sponsoring club and to the D5790 GG Scholarship Chair.
- Sponsoring Rotary Club of selected candidates complete Global Grant Application on www.matchinggrants.org.
- Sponsoring Rotary Club and selected candidate complete Global Grant Application on https://grants.rotary.org, including identifying a sponsor club in the Rotary District where the Scholar's school is located
- 8. Note: Grant Management Training (PE + 1) Required.


