- A minimum of two club members have Attended a Grant Management Seminar in the Rotary Year Prior to your Application
- My Club is current on its Rotary International Dues
- My Club is current on its District 6630 Dues
- My Club has (or will by June 30th) have contributed a minimum of \$40.00 per capita (<u>based on club membership as of July 1, 2021)</u> to the Annual Fund of the Rotary Foundation.
- Submit a correctly signed **TRF MOU** to the District Stewardship Chair. (Appropriate Signatories: The Current PE and next year's PE)
- Submit a correctly signed MOU Addendum to the District Stewardship Chair.
 (Appropriate Signatories: Current PE and next year's PE And any Club Members who attended a Grant Management Seminar if the two previously mentioned individuals did not attend)
- Have all items above approved by the District Foundation Chair and the District Stewardship Chair.
- My Club has entered its 2022-23 Foundation Goal online at www.rotary.org.

Apply for a District Matching Grant (minimum match of \$500 – maximum of \$2500)

- 1. Submit both appropriately signed MOUs (see above) <u>as soon as two club members have</u> <u>attended a Grant Management Seminar.</u>
- 2. Club PE will receive an email from the District Stewardship Chair indicating that your club is qualified. *The Club President and those who attended a GMS will have permission to submit a grant application through the District ClubRunner website only after becoming qualified so be sure to leave ample time to process your qualification before the May 15th Deadline.*
- Grant application Inquiries may be entered into the District website as soon as a club becomes qualified but no later than May 15th to ensure consideration.
- Apply for a Matching Global Grant (minimum of \$30,000 project with at least
 - \$10,715 of Club(s) funding)
 - Submit both appropriately signed MOUs (see above) <u>as soon as two club members have</u> <u>attended a Grant Management Seminar or anytime thereafter</u>.
 - Club PE will receive an email from the District Stewardship Chair indicating that your club is qualified. The Club President and those who attended a GMS will have permission to submit a grant application through the District ClubRunner website (and the TRF website) only after becoming qualified.
 - Global Grant application Inquiries can be entered into the District website at any time throughout the Rotary Year.
