What is Rotary?

Rotary is a global network of 1.4 million leaders, problem-solvers, friends, and neighbors, who see a world where people unite and take action to create lasting change – across the globe, in our communities, and in ourselves.

What is Rotary Youth Exchange?

The Rotary Youth Exchange is a 50-year-old Rotary program that creates an opportunity for young people to make new friends and experience different cultures. It promotes international understanding and friendship through the exchange of experiences and ideas. Students become global citizens by discovering another culture and learning a new language.

The Rotary Youth Exchange builds peace and understanding one young person at a time.

Who is eligible?

The Rotary Youth Exchange is for students ages 15-19.

What is the duration of an Exchange?

- Long-term exchanges last a full academic year, and students attend local schools and live with host families.
- Short-term exchanges last from several days to three months and are often structured as camps, tours, or homestays that take place when school is not in session.

What is the cost?

- Exchanges are valued at over \$24,000 and sponsored by Rotary Clubs in more than 100 countries. Room, board, tuition, and stipend are provided by Rotary.
- Families are responsible for airfare, travel insurance, travel documents, and additional spending money.
