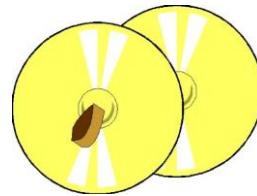

 - g. No repeat projects
 - h. Purchase / support of a specific item rather than donation toward large project
