Navigating Home Page



Once Logged On:



- 1. Address Bar / URL enter <u>www.rotarydistrict5650.org</u> to reach the Rotary District Website
- 2. Login to get access to the private information used by members and clubs; any member in Rotary District 5650 can access the private information by logging in; for assistance with your login ID and password contact exec@rotarydistrict5560.org
- Search click the magnifying glass, type your search words and select the ENTER key on your keyboard
- 4. Go Home select the Rotary District 5650 logo to return home from any screen
- 5. About us to see clubs and make contacts through the website.
- **6.** Exchange Ideas includes Youth Services and Spotlight on Clubs (any club activities that are open to others can be listed here send the information to exec@rotarydistrict5560.org
- 7. Learning & Reference will lead you to almost any page on the District Website; click topics for links to various areas; if there is any particular training topic that you would like us to provide complete the survey under Upcoming District Webinars
- **8.** The Rotary Foundation provides information and forms for Rotary Foundation including the District Grant forms
- **9.** My District has links for the district directory, calendar, organization chart, clubs and contacts; you will be directed to the logon page for specific contact information such as in the directory
- **10.** Once logged in the navigation area changes you will see your name and link for Member Area (discussed later)

ONLINE HELP

KEY MESSGE - ENTER THROUGH CLUBRUNNER - NOT ROTARY.ORG

- Member Information (add, terminate, update)
- Club Officer Information
- Club Meeting Information

Because Rotary District 5650 has chosen to use RI Integration, all of this information must be entered through ClubRunner. It will then process up to Rotary.org.


ClubRunner help:

- Club Subscribers of ClubRunner will find the HELP that is available from ClubRunner very helpful. You will learn about all of the features available to you and your club.

LOGON TO DISTRICT CLUBRUNNER and what you can do

Logon (2. Above) and then go to Member Area (10. above) to go to the Administration Page.

DISTRICT DIRECTORY AND ORGANIZATION INFORMATION

Once logged on you can get detailed contact information for anyone in the district.

Previously we discussed how to perform a search of members using Search Member eDirectory on the Administration page.

District Directory:

For District Directory information we will use the District Directory page from the Home Page of the District Website.

The District Directory is printable and includes district leadership, club leadership, and club meeting information.

Other items traditionally in a District 5650 Directory such as ByLaws, Budget and a list of Past District Governors can also be found on the District Directory page.



District Organization Chart shows a list of District leaders with links to contact them by email but is not in a printable format.

Clubs in our District is in list format, with links to contact leadership and links to the club websites.
