- 1334 Paul Harris Society members.
- 18% of Annual Fund comes from 27,000 Paul Harris Society donors worldwide... ensure a steady stream of income.

Zone 28 - Giving during the pandemic:

- Annual Fund for our 21 districts was \$5.55 million highest since 2017.
- Annual Fund per capita- \$156.18 higher than previous three years.
- 211 major donors and 106 major gifts both categories higher than previous three years.
- PolioPlus donations for Zone 28 were among the top five in the world!

Stats for Zone 32:

- 38.8% of Zone 32 members were EREY (Every Rotarian Every Year) ie, they gave at least \$25 to the Annual Fund last year.
- 29% of Zone 32 members were sustaining members; they gave at least \$100 to the Annual Fund in 20-21.
