In February of 2008 RI President Wilf Wilkinson and Trustee Chair Bob Scott wrote to Canadian Rotary clubs requesting their assistance in contacting their Member of Parliament to urge Canada's continued financial support for Global Polio Eradication. Clubs throughout Canada responded to this call for action by declaring their own commitment to a polio free world and urging Canada's continued support. The Government of Canada heard our collective voice and has announced a commitment of \$60 million over the next three years to
