

STUDENT ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS FOR ROTARY DUNN ENDOWED GLOBAL GRANT SCHOLARSHIP

1. Studies must be in one of the 6 areas of focus mentioned in the following link.

2. Studies must be at an international institution at the graduate level.
3. Proof of admission/acceptance to the international institution is required no later than May 8, 2016.
4. Cannot use scholarship for studies that have already begun.
5. Strong public speaking and interpersonal communication skills
6. High ethical standards demonstrated in their personal, academic or professional lives.
7. Students must be permanent residents of East or West Hartford, CT.
8. Pre departure documents will require proof of insurance that meets The Rotary Foundation (TRF) requirements.
9. Completed scholarship application form with all attachments to be submitted no later than May 8, 2016.
