
Solely from District Designated Funds (no TRF Match)

Most activity and action is local








District must

Account for all funds or return surplus

Close off 2013/14 funding

Review all new applications

Submit a district grant application for
2014/15 projects



FOUNDATION GRANTS


DISTRICT GRANTS

Board must approve the district project

Club must contribute a minimum of 150% of district contribution

AUS projects minimum is \$1000, max \$3,000

International minimum is \$2,000, max \$6,000

DISTRICT GRANTS

Projects must be new ones and not started

Must comply with the TRF terms and Conditions


Progress report by 31st March 2015

Final report by 31st May 2015

50% of funds at start

Final 50% on receipt of progress or final report

Finish in same Rotary year as funding


DISTRICT GRANTS

One project per club


One form include existing project bank account


