Endowment Fund

The Rotary Foundation established an endowment in 1982, now known as the Endowment Fund, to ensure a strong future for the Foundation by providing a continuous stream of income to meet the increasing demand for Foundation programs in perpetuity. Contributions to the Endowment Fund are invested and a portion of the income, as determined annually by the Trustees, is made available for spending.


Gifts to the Endowment Fund enable Rotarians and friends of Rotary to fulfill their local and global philanthropic goals.

A **Benefactor** is an individual or couple that has made a provision in their estate plan to gift a minimum ^{US}\$1,000 to The Rotary Foundation.






