- 1 **Nominating a Person for an Award**

The awards will be judged by panels of Rotarians throughout NSW, who are independent judges, and their decisions will be based purely on the information that you provide. Four (4) finalists will be chosen from each category, totaling 24 finalists to attend the Awards Ceremony; one winner will be announced for each Category; with two (2) from these six (6) winners judged by a panel of District Governors as the two (2) overall Young Inspirational Woman and Inspirational Woman..

- 2 ****Rotarian/Rotaractor women are ineligible to be nominated.**

- 3 **Nominations close at 5pm on Wednesday, 13th June, 2018**

- 4 **Nomination form - Nominations *must be submitted on the attached nomination form*** – additional information may be added to support the nomination.

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
