The Hills-Kellyville Rotary club is sending a team of seven to work with [BlazeAid](#) in the Coonabarabran area rebuilding farm fencing destroyed in the recent bushfires.

The arrangement is that BlazeAid arranges the volunteer labour and the farmers need to supply the materials. However, the materials alone for one kilometre of simple wire fence cost more than \$2,000 and many farmers have difficulty in finding the money to buy the materials. Because of the terrible recent droughts, many farmers had not been able to keep their insurances up to date and the result for a lot is that source of funding is not available to them.

So if you would like to help us help them, you might like to donate some fence wire or star pickets to us to take up there. Or you might like to make a donation to BlazeAid so they can buy some materials in Coonabarabran.

We are leaving Sydney over the Easter Weekend so the timing of donations of materials is a bit critical.


