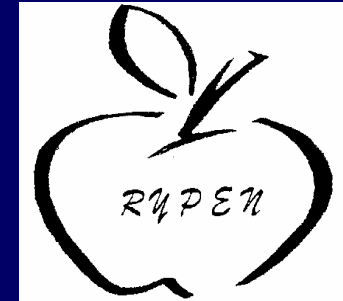

What will we do at RYPEN?

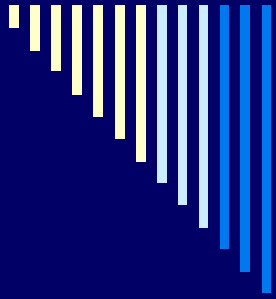
- The activities at RYPEN include workshops, talks, outdoor activities, problem solving, hands-on activities, sports and entertainment.

When is RYPEN?

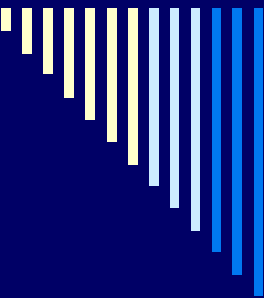
- RYPEN for Rotary District 9685 will take place from:

What does it cost my club

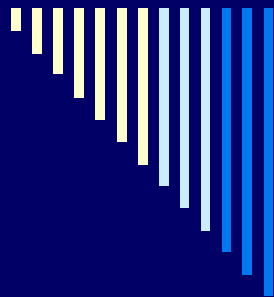
- Only \$360 per student for Narrabeen

What does my club do now

- 1: Find 2 suitable RYPEN Candidates 1 boy and 1 girl preferably
 - 2: Send completed Application Form **with Cheque or direct deposit**
 - Made out to Rotary District 9685 RYPEN and send it with your applications
 - 3: Invite Candidates to 1 or 2 Rotary Meetings
 - 4: Check to see if Acceptance Instructions have been received from District
 - 5: Organise transport to and from the camp if Parents can not drive students.
 - 6: A driver arranged to bring the students home if an emergency arises and
 - Phone Number is given to RYPEN committee
 - **After the camp**
 - 7: RYPEN Students invited back to the Rotary Club to tell of their experience
 - 8: Organise for the press to be at the meeting or take photos and send to paper

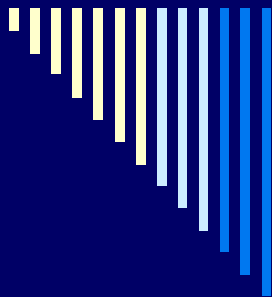


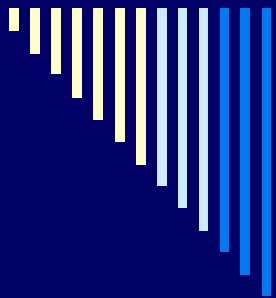
