## EndTrachoma by 2020

#### What is Trachoma?

Trachomatous inflammation follicular (TF)
The presence of five or more follicles in the upper tarsal conjunctiva of at least 0.5 mm



Trachomatous inflammation intense (TI) Pronounced inflammatory thickening of the tarsal conjunctiva that obscures more than half of the normal deep tarsal vessels



#### Trachomatous scarring (TS)

Presence of scarring in the tarsal conjunctiva



#### Trachomatous trichiasis (TT)

At least one eyelash rubs on the eyeball or there is evidence of recent removal of in-turned eyelashes.



#### Corneal opacity (CO)

Easily visible corneal opacity over the pupil




**Figure 1.1.** Simplified trachoma grading classification system from the World Health Organization.

## Sponsor Active Health

= 134 Clubs = **\$746 per club** 









SYDNEY UNI OPTION
Graduate Diploma in Indigenous Health Promotion

Rotary Scholarship - Option 2 (Alice Springs w/shops)

12 students (min) @ \$10,000 each = \$120,000

Plus dedicated academic support (2yrs) = \$100,000

Joint venture with D9675

= 134 Clubs = **\$1641 per club**

## WHO IS INVOLVED

- Inclusion Leagues promote play for all people with disabilities from both a participation and competition stand point.
- Wheelchair users, cerebral palsy, blind, deaf, autism, down syndrome, amputee participants can all play with and against each other in an adapted environment.
- They are also part of a main stream club, competition and sport.



#### **ADAPTIONS REQUIRED**

These inclusion leagues are adapted by rules and by game equipment to enhance the experience of participants across all disability groups.







#### SPORT CAMPS FOR SOCIAL INCLUSION

Social isolation is a big challenge for people with disabilities!

Sport NSW are embarking on a project that will have sport and active recreation play a key role in enhancing the social well being of all people with disabilities.

Social recreation inclusion camps will be launched in November of 2018 and will focus on easy to adapt recreation sessions with a large social component at a PCYC club or through a council / community organisation.

Australian Rotary Health is one of the largest independent funders of mental health research within Australia.


In addition to mental health research, we also provide funding into a broad range of general health areas, provide scholarships for rural medical and nursing students, as well as Indigenous health students.

Australian Rotary Health provides funding into areas of health that do not readily attract funding, and promotes findings to the community.












## **AUSTRALIA'S EPIDEMIC**















# Manly Warringah Women's Resource Centre

Manly Warringah Women's Resource Centre (MWWRC) is a not for profit community-based service for women and vulnerable families, including women and children escaping domestic and family violence.





# A convergence of ideals

Our aim is to ensure women, children and families are safe, secure, connected and given the opportunity and environment to thrive and achieve their aspirations.

# Mosman Rotary

Created a program of support specifically designed to reach the most vulnerable women and children at

Bringa and Delvena Women and Children's Refuge

\$20,000 fund

(Dick Smith Humanitarian Foundation Fund + Mosman Rotary Community Funds – Monopoly Fundraiser)

\$6,000 fund

(\$3000 + \$3000 District Grant)

**10** x vulnerable families escaping domestic violence received **\$2000 Mosman Rotary** package of support covering:

- rent for six weeks
- food for six weeks
- clothing vouchers
- Opal cards for transport
- New bed linen package ecodownunder

Delvena Women and Children Refuge, Lower North Shore Sydney received \$6,000 to enable necessary refurbishment



# Packages of commitment

#### Women

#### Dignity package

Experience shows it takes up to six weeks to access financial support or Centrelink after leaving a domestic violence relationship. \$2000 provides six weeks of support, relief and a strong sense of **dignity**.

#### Pride package

Few families access their possessions after leaving a domestic violence relationship. In setting up a new home, families need everything – beds, mattresses, TV, table/chairs, lounge, fridge, washing machine. \$2000 ensures each family regains **pride** in their home.

#### Welcome package

We can accommodate up to 45 families per year in 11 rooms/apartments across two refuges. Refurbishment of rooms is ongoing. \$2000 refreshes the space and **welcomes** each family with new mattresses, pillows, doonas, sheets, rugs, crockery and cutlery.

#### Children

#### School package

Financial abuse impacts children also and their ability to **excel in life**. \$1000 will cover uniforms, books, bags, school shoes, sports clothes, excursions and after school activities be it sport, music or swimming lessons.

#### Wellbeing package

Research shows that children's exposure to domestic violence is associated with a range of cognitive and behavioural problems and poorer academic outcomes. \$1000 enriches a child to ten weeks of therapeutic programs to improve their wellbeing.

#### Fun package

Children who have escaped a household dominated by tension and fear may find **solace in enjoyment** and fun. \$500 will provide them with a day out, a school holiday activity, a action packed day on the harbour, a simple day of building sand castles at the beach..
