1. **Connect Clubs** - and to share information - so that we can work cooperatively to continually improve our service to other communities.





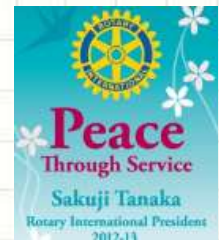
