





ROTARY'S NEW GRANT MODEL FINISHES FIRST YEAR SUPPORTING OUR SIX AREAS OF FOCUS




UPDATE ON ROTARY FOUNDATION






End Polio Now: Make History Today campaign

From 2013 to 2018, every \$1 Rotary commits to direct support for polio immunization will be matched 2-to-1(up to \$35 million per year) by the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation. If fully realized, the campaign will result in \$525 million for polio eradication.
