Rotary Clubs in Districts 9750 and 9680

Dear fellow Rotarians:

At its recent May 2011 meeting, the Board of Directors of Rotary International agreed to reorganize the clubs in Districts 9750, 9690 and 9680 into two new districts, effective 1 July 2013, as follows:

District 9675: AUSTRALIA, that portion of New South Wales bounded by the Pacific Ocean from midway between Gerringong and Kiama ; north to South Head; west into Sydney Harbour; west on Parramatta River; to James Ruse Drive, north west to Old Windsor Road (Metroad 2); along Old Windsor Road to intersection with M7; due west to the intersection of The Northern Road (Metroad 9) and Ninth Avenue; south to the Western Motorway (M4) ; west to Nepean River; south on the Nepean River to Warragamba River; south to Warragamba Dam and a straight line south east to mid way between Gerringong and Kiama

District 9685: AUSTRALIA, that portion of New South Wales bounded by the Pacific Ocean from North Head; north to Catherine Hill Bay; due west to 150E/33S; due south to 150E/34S; east to Warragamba Dam; north along Warragamba River to Nepean River; north along Nepean River to the Western Motorway (M4); east to The Northern Road (Metroad 9); north to Ninth Avenue; due E to intersection of Old Windsor Road (Metroad 2) and M7; south east along Old Windsor Road to James Ruse Drive; south east to Parramatta River; east to Sydney Harbour and thence to North Head.

In accordance with the Board's decision, clubs in Districts 9750 and 9680 may file any objections to the above decision so as to reach the RI general secretary within 45 days of the mailing date of this decision.
