YOUTH PROTECTION AND HARASSMENT.

- **2.120 Conduct for Rotary Events and Activities.**
- Rotary is committed to maintaining an environment that promotes safety, courtesy, dignity and respect. All Rotary club members and individuals attending or participating in Rotary events or activities have the right to an environment free of harassment, including unwelcome physical contact, advances, or comments.

Allegations of Unwelcome Behaviour.

Allegations of unwelcome physical contact advances or comments at Rotary events or activities shall be reviewed by the Governor, or a committee appointed for this purpose and responded to within a reasonable time frame.
